Subject: Economic Prosperity for the Citizens of Florida, the United States, and the World

Dear Governor Crist,

Thank you for your letter dated June 10, 2009. I'm glad to see that someone in authority is actually concerned about justice in the country. Your letter recommends that I should call the Office of Citizen Services. I believe that my situation is not addressable by any programs that you currently offer which is one of the reasons why I can not begin to lead the country out of its present economic recession. The biggest problems that exist in our present system of capitalism is that patents are not awarded to the correct individuals by the Patent Office. Although we have 275,000 trash patents being processed through the office yearly, we have only a hand full of my marketable inventions that are fought over and stolen by the first, or second, and occasionally a third, intellectual property (inventor) theftor. In recent years, since 2004, I cut off the supply of marketable inventions when I started my business although they continue to be taken by espionage. The promise of a granting of a patent in exchange for revealing the subject matter an invention is just a cruel lie. The other problem is the perception that invention begins in company R&D departments and university labs. The reality is that invention can only occur in one innovative individual's mind. Genetics of the individual with regards to inventing ability will determine the ability to create the inventions. Also, the ability to invent begins at an extreme young age and continues through the individual's lifetime. Until we end such practices as corporate R&D invention back dating, inter company memos, claims of obscure previous existence with falsified documentation, and more than 30 methods of cheating inventors, we cannot begin to have any honesty or integrity within our patent system. The sad fact is that the only thing that an inventor will receive for his efforts is a 10 or 12 year lawsuit that he can't even afford to file under our present system. This conspiracy to defraud inventors is massive in size and involves potentially many U.S. Presidents, Congress, and the Florida Legislature. We are now in a state of invention stagnation due the huge volume of money that would potentially be owed due to the frauds that have occurred in the past. Also, please see legislation changes that can be implemented to make the U.S. and the World Patent System the most honest and integritious system possible. Perhaps you might direct my company to bill writing legislators willing to sponsor this critically important legislation into both Florida, national, and international, legislation. We

need to change industry's perception that large investments in R&D and the hiring of a large number of engineers will somehow produce invention and innovation. History has shown that it won't unless one of those individuals came into contact with me or one of my grandfathers. Businesses need to become aware of the new reality of special order intellectual property creations is the only conscientious integritious method of obtaining new intellectual property. I have complained to patent office about these previous robberies and asked them to stop having their personnel approach me with efforts to illegally gain valuable intellectual properties. I wrote to you previously regarding the concept of the state funding these new invention ideas; however, this would require the belief by yourself and the citizens of Florida that this is actually the source of original invention conception. Please feel free to visit our website and check out the many historical inventions that my grandfathers conceived. I have conceived all or nearly all major and most minor marketable inventions since 1953 after genetically inheriting the ability from my grandfathers.

I believe that your present program the involves attempts to attract business to the state could be largely and economically augmented through the implementation of a program that would, by committee, select the most viable new products that my company or other companies, theoretically, can produce and invest state funds into those approved inventions. This panel of experts can consist of marketing experts. The state could appropriate funds or back loans for business startups by analyzing a owner managers core group's abilities to be financially successful. I feel that the repayment pool of money that would be repaid to the state could charge an interest percentage and actually proliferate its original startup capital as long as correct choices were made as far as funding allocation with regards to the investment choices available.
